Welcome back! This week we will be creating a storyboard and soundtrack to share a snapshot of our lives at the moment.

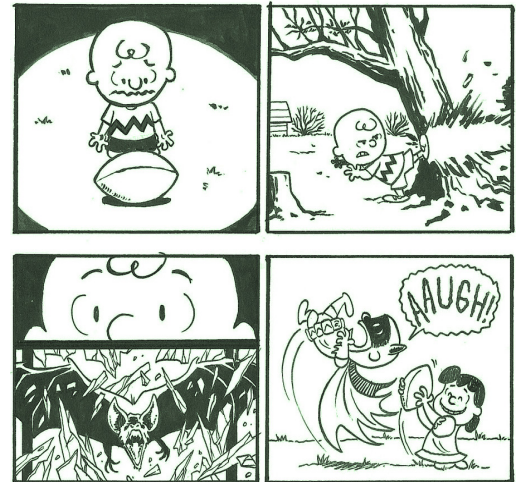
1 Frame by frame

Use drawing to create a storyboard about what your world looks like at the moment.

You will need: A piece of paper, x1 coloured pen/pencil of your choice

Suggested steps:

- **Fold** your paper into 4 by folding it in half and in half again!
- **Think about** something you've done today or something you wish you could have done today to start you off.
- **Draw** it out frame by frame into your four sections making it bold and clear, with lots of detail.

2 Artist Postal Service

Share a picture of your world as a postcard to send to family or a friend.

You will need: A6 sized card, pens/pencils, your storyboard, an address & stamp.

Suggested steps:

- **Choose** your favorite frame from your storyboard and recreate this onto your A6 piece of card.
- **Make** it bold and colourful!
- **Write** a message on the back, and add an address for someone you would like to send it to, don't forget to add a stamp.
- **Include** a return address and become penpals!



3 Making instruments

Using recycled and found materials create your own instruments.

You will need:

- Recycled materials i.e cardboard, foil, plastic containers, rubber bands.
- Scissors, glue & tape

Suggested steps:

- **Think** about what you can use around you to create sounds, perhaps a rubber band over an old tin or bottle caps stuck to folded cardboard.
- **Play** around and invent your own! but make sure it creates sound.



4 Score it!

Use your homemade instruments to create a score for your storyboard.

You will need:

- Your homemade instruments
- Your storyboard
- A phone to record your soundtrack.

Suggested steps:

- **Think** about your storyboard, what sounds do you want it to make?
- **Use** your instruments to create these sounds, for example tapping to a beat to create happiness and joy.
- **Add** a song or simple narration.
- **Record** your unique soundtrack using your phone.
